Dear Martial Arts Enthusiast,

My name is Will Higginbotham and I have been involved in Martial Arts most of my life. I began my journey back in September of 1968. In that time, I have been witness to many types of training and have trained under some of the most prolific Martial Artists anywhere.

I am hosting two camps this summer and have enclosed the flyers for them. The first camp is the Midwest Small Circle Jujitsu Camp. Small Circle Jujitsu was created by Professor Wally Jay (Bruce Lee's last teacher). Since Prof. Jay's passing back in 2011 at the age of 94, his son Professor Leon Jay has continued to develop the system and help make it grow to a worldwide recognized art.

This system can be used to enhance any art to help any student reach higher levels of proficiency in Self Defense. It includes a study of Small Circle Judo basics for the throws and sweeps, Finger locks, Wrist locks, Arm and Shoulder locks, Arm bars, strikes, kicks, weapons and a heavy pressure point component.

In August we will have our 19<sup>th</sup> annual Dillman Karate International Camp also here in the Indianapolis area. At these camps we have sessions on how to use pressure points and how to use them in breaking down forms or katas. If you have a forms based system you will go home with a deeper understanding of them. If you don't have forms, the information and techniques taught will still enhance any system.

Both camps are for those wanting more out of their Martial Arts. More effectiveness, more meaning, more self-confidence and more depth. We offer you an invitation to come and be a part of the learning sessions at the camp and take it back to your students. You can bring any of your students with you to increase the knowledge base for your most senior people or students who you wish to develop. Our hope is to bring up the level of every art in understanding the secrets that the Senior Masters from generations past left for us to un-lock and share. High tides lift all boats. It is our hope that everyone will feel welcome to come and experience both of these camps.
